## FUTURE CRUISE NEWS!

Lodge #572's pioneering Caribbean Cruise, this past January, was a tremendous success, as most are aware. Many members have expressed regret that they were unable, for various reasons, to participate in this first-ever Elks offering. Due to such responses, we have now made special arrangements with our "Sister Cruise Lodge" in Crestwood, MO., to join their January 8, 2006 Cruise to Aruba, Curacao, St. Thomas, & St. Maarten. The Crestwood Elks package includes flight from St. Louis to San Juan, Puerto Rico, & return. (Depending on number interested transportation to St. Louis maybe included, or at the least, avoidance of airport parking fees, by going to the Crestwood Lodge and boarding their bus to Lambert.) In San Juan, group will board Royal Caribbean ship, Adventure of the Seas, for the Cruise. Members of #572 can buy in at Crestwood's special group rate, which includes port taxes, air fare, on-board Cocktails parties, and complimentary wine.
