At present, it does not appear that any legislative action will modify or alter this impending new law. Private organizations are currently NOT excluded. Therefore, if you are someone who does smoke, you will need to prepare for this likely eventuality, come 1/1/2008. As fines for infractions will be severe for the establishment

you are in, we will have to strictly adhere to the smoking ban. Health Departments in each County will enforce the ban. The Illinois Department of Public Health is now writing the specific rules and regulations for the Law. Your Lodge Officers will be looking at these regulations, and determining if / how we can reasonably accommodate our members who smoke.

For those of you who are reading this message, please try to make it a personal goal to sponsor one new, quality member this year. When you come to your Lodge, pick up a convenient tri-fold application and keep it in your vehicle, as I do. There are buttons we plan to acquire that say, "I am an Elk, ask me why."
