PROGRESS REPORT ON C.C.C. DART TOURNEY AND AUCTION

It is difficult to extend adequate thanks to **ALL** who contributed, participated, helped, and otherwise supported our February 23rd fund raiser for Ill. Elks Children's Care Corporation (formerly Crippled Children's Corporation). Chairman, Keith Roberts, indicated that over 300 individual contributors, businesses, and organizations chipped in to help. As of this Newsletter's publication, over **\$11,000.00** was raised at this particular event. A great turnout of people watched, bid on auction items, and generally enjoyed themselves as some 84 individuals competed on Dart Teams. And, it should be noted that many of those who contributed, in a wide variety of ways, were not Elks, but Elk guests and friends who believe in and support the work of our State Major Project. How well this speaks for the reputation of the C.C.C., as well as the BPO ELKS, in general!

And, since the pioneering inception of a Dart Tournament for the C.C.C. in 1995-96, your Lodge has now, in this 13th year, seen total Lodge contributions for said time period reach a new milestone. We have just passed the \$250,000.00 mark!!!! (Said another way, that's a QUARTER MILLION.) And, recall that **100%** of these dollars have gone to help Kids in Need...not 1 cent of administrative cost!) 
