## ENF SCHOLARSHIPS

The Elks National Foundation offers the following Scholarships. Most Valuable Student scholarships are open to all High School Seniors, nationwide. A total of 500 will be awarded, with \$2.296 million given out in amounts ranging from \$4,000 \$60,000. Criteria includes scholarship, leadership, and financial need. As these scholarships are very competitive, students need to be in the top 5% to 10% of their class to have a realistic chance of winning an award. Legacy Awards are open to children or grandchildren (Inc. stepchild, grandchild, or legal ward) of paid-up Elks who joined the order on or before April 1, 2006. The ENF awards up to 250 of these, nationwide, based on seniors who exhibit the values of the National Foundation - Knowledge, Charity, Community, and Integrity. (Also, Emergency Grants are available to students under the age of 23, whose Elk parent is deceased or totally disabled. See contact information, below.) The deadline for seniors to submit the MVS application to the Elk Lodge nearest their home is January 9, 2009. Legacy applications have the same postmark deadline, and must be mailed to the ENF in Chicago. 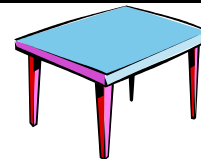


