ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

There are basically 3 different scholarship programs sponsored by the ENF. They are as follows:

Most Valuable Student - Also known as the MVS, these 500 nation-wide scholarships are open to application by ALL High School Seniors who are American citizens (No Elk affiliation required). Applications are now available, on-line only, at www.elks.org/enf/scholars. Judging is based on Scholarship, Leadership, and Financial need. Deadline is on or before December 4, 2015.

Legacy Awards - these 250 awards are now open to application by High School Seniors who are children or grandchildren of current, dues-paying Elks who joined the Order on or before April 1, 2013. (Applicants compete against other applicants from the state of their sponsoring Elk Lodge.) Applications on-line only, at www.elks.org/enf/scholars. Submission deadline is January 29, 2016.

Emergency Grants - Provide monetary assistance to children of deceased or totally disabled Elks in the form of renewable, one-year Grants of up to \$4,000. (Must demonstrate financial need, be unmarried, & under the age of 23 as of Dec. 31 in year of application.) Applications available by calling (between May 1 and Oct. 31 of academic year for which assistance is requested) ENF Office at 773/755/4732 or e-mailing scholarship@elks.org. 
