Several of our Lodge Officers traveled to Springfield the weekend of May 19th-21st to attend the IEA State Meeting. Our new IEA State President, Dave Jurmu of Rock Island Lodge #980, has established a theme for this year of "Get On Board." Murphysboro Lodge #572 did a great job of this, last year. We had a membership gain of 10 members; we met all of our ENF Goals; we took 1st place at State and District level in gross donations to our Elks Children's Care Corporation, as well as 1st place in South District for per-capita donations; our Lodge sponsored the <u>IEA State Elk of the Year</u> (Don't forget to congratulate Rick Ehlers on this fantastic achievement). Now, let us keep all these things in mind as we go through our current Lodge year. Each of us has a friend, a family member, or a co-worker whom we think would make a good <u>Elk Member</u>. Let's try to do our part in signing up new members and working together on our fund- raising efforts to help our Veterans, our Children and our community.
