MEMBERSHIP GAIN AT LODGE #572

While not a whole "Herd" of Elks were added - an <u>INCREASE</u> was achieved this past year! Here are the statistics: We began the year at 666. Added were 28 new members and 5 reinstates, for a total of plus 33. Unfortunately, there were 7 deaths during 2018 - 2019. On 3/31/2019, membership stood at 692 - but 21 (3.1%) Delinquents were dropped for non-payment, resulting in our April 1 figure of 671.....or a gain of 5, putting our Murphysboro Lodge at a <u>historically</u> high, beginning membership! Now - looking ahead to the coming year - it is YOU, our members, who sponsor and mentor new candidates. Let's have another great year.
